- 1** Have a read through the A4 paper layout guide and useful tips below.
- 2** Enjoy creating your designs – take a look at our Creative Tips for inspiration.
- 3** Collect artworks and fill in the class lists attached. Choose a different letter for each class A, B, C, etc. Allocate each child within the class with the different consecutive number A01, A02, etc.
Write it on the back of each artwork.
- 4** Hand out the Order Forms provided along with the artworks to each parent – request to return Order Forms and artwork by specific date if they wish to place an order.

Collage materials can look great, though elements should be securely stuck down and flat to the paper. (No pegs or pasta for example).

Please use strong, contrasting colours, as these will reproduce best. No glitter please – it gets everywhere!

Please note that colours are deliberately enhanced and an exact colour match to the original artwork cannot be guaranteed.

If using paint, try to use nice and heavy paper.

A4 Paper layout

Measure roughly 9cm from the top of your A4 paper.

Older children can write their name and draw a self-portrait in the top section.

For younger children, please write clearly the child's name on the back top left hand corner.

Now fold the top section back to create a square area for the artwork.

Useful tips

Brighter and bolder the colours reproduce the best.
We advice you to use colours to the background.
You can use various techniques such as paint, tissue paper, collaging with different materials and finger painting.

Pencil or pencil crayons, biro, light water colours and flourescent colours - they will not reproduce well.
No glitter and no bulky items - they are not good for scanners.
Metalic colours and sequins becomes reflective during scanning.

The selfportrait and the name will be printed on the back.
Please use thick bold pens.

Creative Tips

Balloon Flowers

Stick some coloured paper down as a background.



Stick down some felt shapes (we found some at local craft shop) and add some shiny stickers and a bow.



Use a piece of thread for stalks to finish off.



Colourful Flowers



Use the child's hand to make green prints, holes should be painted over with green paint.

Secondly, stick some crumbled colorful tissue paper onto the printed fingers.



To finish off, cut out a bow and stick it at the bottom.



Rainbow Flower

We created an explosive background using two colours – a brown base and creamy strips. Make sure your background isn't too bright, we don't want your flowers to look dull.



We then cut out some big, rounded petals in rainbow colours and add the middle. Pick your favourites if you prefer.



Cut out some smaller, sharp-edged petals of the same colour and add them to your design. Your design is a complete, beautiful flower.
